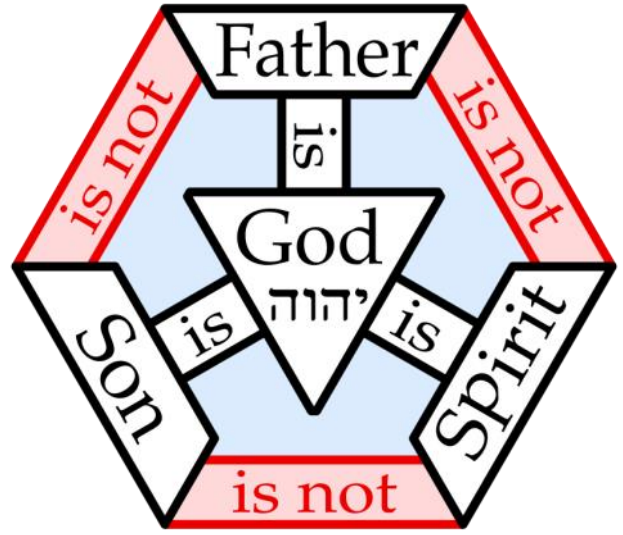

What kind of puzzle is this? Maybe that's the thought some folks have about our Christian understanding of the Trinity!  $1+1+1=1$ ??? It can seem like some kind of puzzle, or word game, or even just nonsense. But we believe the Trinity is the most important thing to "get" about our faith. *Trinity* is a word coined by St. Augustine which means "the union of three" or "three fold sharing". It is really just another way of saying "God is love" and that love is life. We were made by love, by relationship...and we are made for those things too. This illustration speaks to that a bit. It says something about God and something about us. God is Father, Son, and Spirit. Each is individual, i.e. the Father is not the Son, but all are united. It also says something about us, those strange "is" and "is not" phrases. It says that outside of the Trinity, outside of God, nothing came to be. Just like the Book of Genesis says. God is a communion of people sharing love amongst themselves, and...with us. ~Fr. Matt
